

Trimming Target Plan (January)

South of Summerlin Parkway

- Prune dormant lantana and salvia to encourage spring regrowth
- Prune grasses (red fountain, regal mist, and deer) to encourage spring regrowth
- Complete trimming the shrubs in the entryways, mini-parks and breezeways in the Arbors North (50% remaining) and start the Arbors South
- Trim pyracantha as needed

North of Summerlin Parkway

- Prune dormant lantana and salvia to encourage spring regrowth
- Prune grasses (red fountain, regal mist, and deer) to encourage spring regrowth
- Prune sages and cassias in the Arbors North and Arbors South on the cyclic three-year program for plant rejuvenation
- Complete trimming the shrubs in the entryways, mini-parks, and breezeways in the Pueblo (50% remaining) and start the Hills North
- Trim pyracantha as needed

Summerlin North

- Continue shrub and tree fertilization program throughout Summerlin North as needed
- Continue mechanical and chemical post-emergent and chemical pre-emergent weed control throughout Summerlin North
- Continue weekly trash pickup and doggi-pot servicing throughout Summerlin North
- Continue bi-weekly mowing schedule throughout Summerlin North
- Continue winter cleanup of all fallen leaves throughout Summerlin North
