Exercising a Timely Dose of Healthy Communication

I know you're all very active out there. Our community management teams have never been busier navigating a virtual tsunami of outdoor projects undertaken by well-meaning residents seeking to preserve/enhance/improve their properties. That's the good news, 38,000+ households exhibiting meaningful pride of ownership. My only caution before you start any project would be to make sure you have done your homework. (Sorry, I couldn't resist).

If you are giving your home a fresh coat of paint using your same existing colors, or replacing dead trees or shrubs with the same species, then you're good to go. However, if you desire to make any changes to existing paint colors or landscape materials, please remember that any improvements that alter the

exterior appearance of your property must have prior written approval from the association. This includes all rear, side, and front yard improvements, including landscape.

On behalf of your volunteer gatekeeper's, i.e. those who serve on your respective community Boards, Compliance Advisory Committees and Design Review Committees, I highly encourage you to take the time to submit for proper approval before you start making any changes to your property.

The purpose of this primary restriction is simple. It is the most fair and effective way to help assure the visual continuity of neighborhood and community aesthetics. A Sunday drive through Summerlin goes a long way in illustrating how well the concept has

Management of this member responsibility is accomplished through the community's adopted Design Guidelines and Standards. The ever-evolving document describes the current criteria that exists for typical exterior home and landscape improvements and outlines the procedure for proper member submittal and approval. You can find this information on Summerlink.com.

It is important to note that the Design Guidelines and Standards do not seek to restrict individual taste or preferences. In general, the intent is to avoid harsh contrasts in the community's architectural themes and landscapes, thus helping to ensure visual harmony within Summerlin.

Administration of your property improvement submittals is accomplished through each respective association's Design Review Committees. Each submittal is reviewed by your Design Review Administrator or Committee to determine if the proposed improvement or modification conforms in appearance and design with the adopted standards of the community. Their goal is to process each submittal in a consistent, fair, and timely manner while serving as your guardian to the community guidelines and standards that protect all members.

It is impossible to over-emphasize the importance of each resident adhering to the community design review

process. As some residents have learned the hard way, plan submittal and approval prior to installation are not only community requirements, but also an effective way to avoid costly remodifications and bruised relationships with fellow neighbors.



ARE YOU PLANNING TO REPAINT YOUR HOME?

In answering this common question, please note that there is no pre-approved paint scheme for any residential properties in Summerlin West. All requests to alter the exterior color scheme of individual properties are reviewed on a case-by-case basis with consideration being given to the architectural style of the residence, the color of existing roof tile and/or stone veneer on the residence, the number of contrasting colors originally on the home, the color palette of the surrounding neighborhood, etc. The use of original paint colors in the original locations is considered routine maintenance and does not require approval.

The specific procedures and information for submitting your painting request are described in Article V., Section B. of the Association's Design Guidelines and Standards.

When submitting you must provide the following:

- A completed Improvement Request form. (a copy of this form is located on Summerlink.com/ Homeowners Summerlin West/Design Review/ Improvement Request Form)
- A blocking plan/elevation drawing detailing which colors will be used on the exterior surfaces of the home.
- An accurate set of paint chips showing the name and manufacturer's code for each of the proposed colors.
- Confirm the paint colors selected is not the same color scheme as your neighbors to the immediate right, left and directly across the street from your residence.

In an effort to ensure the review process is effectively administered and that individual property owners are treated equitably we review submittals only in the order they are received.

Summerlines welcomes your news and information about Summerlin West. All submittals should be sent to: News from the West, 2115 Festival Plaza Drive Suite 220, Las Vegas, NV 89135. All material submitted must be informative and of interest to the residents at large. It must be for non-commercial purposes, non-political in nature, factual, presented in a format that is not prejudicial or biased, presented within a time frame that allows for its review prior to publication (allow six weeks lead time), typewritten, double spaced and in a type size no smaller than twelve (12) point. If the information regards an issue outside the jurisdiction of the Association, it must be determined by the Board of Directors to affect the safety and/or welfare of the entire Association. The writer will be held accountable for the content of the information and the Board of Directors reserves the right to edit or decline to publish any submission.




